**\*UPDATE ON CAPITAL CAMPAIGN**  
We have an exciting update on the capital campaign to share with the congregation: we have met our goal! As of April 29, Congregation members have pledged \$70,920 so far, and we have received \$12,300 in unpledged gifts. When we add in the money council allocated to the campaign from a bequest, this brings us to \$103,220, which is 103% of our goal. We have already received \$51,470.  
Thank you to everyone for your incredible generosity! Thanks to your support, we have already

completed the Fellowship Hall roof. New doors for the office-side entrance are also on order.
